NOTICE OF QUESTIONS

(FOR ORAL ANSWER ON MONDAY 23RD JUNE, 2025)

1. **KGOSI MOSADI (GA-MALETE):** To ask the Minister of Local Government and Traditional Affairs to update this Honourable House on the number of tribes that have been recognised as Tribal Communities under Section (3) of the Bogosi Act CAP 41:01 of April 2008 since its enactment. **(1)**
2. **KGOSI J. D. KHUMANEGO (NGWAKETSE WEST REGION):** To ask the Minister of Transport and Infrastructure to apprise this Honourable House on progress made regarding the construction of the Kokong junction road which was promised by a former Minister during a Kgotla meeting held on 19th September, 2024 as and reported on the Daily Newspaper of the same date. **(2)**
3. **KGOSI LOTLAMORENG II (BAROLONG):** To ask the Minister for State President to explain to this Honourable House if:- **(3)**
 - (i) he does not deem it necessary to construct a police post at Pitsane village considering the crime rate at that village; and
 - (ii) he will consider renovating the Goodhope Police Station.
4. **KGOSI D. NDHOWE (OKAVANGO REGION):** To ask the Minister of Transport and Infrastructure to update this Honourable House on progress made regarding the conversion of the Mohembo-Gudigwa road to bitumen. **(4)**

- 5. KGOSI KGARI III (BAKWENA):** To ask the Minister for State President to state when he will construct a state of the art Police station in Molepolole at the Thari ya Banana plot as it was assured to the community by the then Minister of Defence, Justice and Security at a Kgotla meeting held on the 18th October, 2024. **(5)**
- 6. KGOSI KHAMA IV (GA MMANGWATO):** To ask the Minister of Justice and Correctional Services whether he is aware that a letter was written to him by the Former Permanent Secretary to the President, Carter Morupisi about the conditions of Prisons while a similar report was given to the Ntlo ya Dikgosi by the Commissioner; and if so:- **(6)**
- (i) what steps is the Ministry taking as a matter of urgency to address the unacceptable situation, as described; and
 - (ii) when can a delegation of Ntlo ya Dikgosi engage on a fact finding mission to the Prisons.
- 7. KGOSI T. MUNDUU (NGAMI REGION):** To ask the Minister for State President if he is aware that Members of Ntlo ya Dikgosi are not assisted with transport by the Department of Tribal Administration as the department has issues of lack of transport across the country; and if so, whether he will consider providing Members of Ntlo ya Dikgosi with a regional allowance to assist them to address other Dikgosi in their respective regions. **(7)**
- 8. KGOSI N. KABELO (SEROWE REGION):** To ask the Minister of Lands and Agriculture if he will consider conducting a forensic land audit covering all allocations made at Paje Sub Land Board for the past seven (7) years including those for the current Land Board officials, employees and councillors. **(8)**
- 9. KGOSI M. KHACHANA (NORTH EAST):** To ask the Minister of Transport and Infrastructure if he is aware that community residential houses in Tshesebe village cracked during the construction of the A1 road in 2010 due to quarry blasting; and if so, how he intends to assist the affected owners. **(9)**

- 10. KGOSI T. M. MONYEPELE (TSWAPONG REGION):** To ask the Minister of Local Government and Traditional Affairs to inform this Honourable House on:- **(10)**
- (i) whether he will amend the Bogosi Act to make provision for issues concerning a tribe's lineage and/or hierarchy to chieftaincy which often lead to misunderstanding in regard to who should assume the seat of a Kgosi; and further state,
 - (ii) the set procedures regarding lodging an appeal over chieftaincy disputes, if any.
- 11. KGOSI D. NDHOWE (OKAVANGO REGION):** To ask the Minister of Finance if he will consider reversing the decision on the Public Service Officers' pay dates to the old ones as the current arrangement disadvantages many officers. **(11)**
- 12. KGOSI KHAMA IV (GA MMANGWATO):** To ask the Minister of Justice and Correctional Services whether he is aware that in the Butterfly case, the State blatantly and illogically fabricated an affidavit in order to falsely prosecute innocent people and in the process, damaging the reputation of the country and national bank, and relations with other countries' financial institutions and Government; and if so:- **(12)**
- (i) what steps is the Ministry taking to hold to account those political leaders and public officers who engaged in the unlawful act; and
 - (ii) how the Minister intends to correct the reputational harm that was caused by the State on the affected individuals.
- 13. KGOSI MOSADI (GA-MALETE):** To ask the Minister for State President to state when he will repair the boundary fence between Ga-Malete in the Republic of Botswana and the Republic of South Africa to lessen criminal activities of stock theft and illegal crossing perpetuated by criminals from both countries. **(13)**

- 14. KGOSI N. KABELO (SEROWE REGION):** To ask the Minister of Lands and Agriculture to update this Honourable House on progress made regarding the refurbishment of the milk processing plant in Serowe. **(14)**
- 15. KGOSI T. MUNDUU (NGAMI REGION):** To ask the Minister for State President if he is aware that the villages of Qangwa, Xai-Xai, Dobe border and Qhoshe fall under the Affirmative Action Programme but do not have a Botswana Police Service vehicle and that the villages, are serviced from as far as Gumare; which is 200 kilometres away from Xai-Xai village; and if so, when he will provide a vehicle for the above villages. **(15)**
- 16. KGOSI J. D. KHUMANEGO (NGWAKETSE WEST REGION):** To ask the Minister of Transport and Infrastructure to explain the cause of delay in the re-sealing of the Mabutsane-Morwamosu road; and further state, when the re-sealing of the road will commence. **(16)**
- 17. KGOSI M. KHACHANA (NORTH EAST):** To ask the Minister for State President to inform this Honourable House on how he will address the issue of overstaying of Botswana Police Service officers in one (1) station with no transfer nor promotion. **(17)**

(FOR ORAL ANSWER ON TUESDAY 24TH JUNE, 2025)

- 1. KGOSI KHAMA IV (GA MMANGWATO):** To ask the Minister of Justice and Correctional Services to inform this Honourable House whether in the Butterfly case, the State hired Gerrie Nel as its legal counsel; and if so:- **(18)**
- (i) how much has been paid so far for his services;
 - (ii) is there any amount owed to him and if any, how much;
 - (iii) since the Butterfly case was wholly initiated by law enforcement agencies without external influence as per the State claim, why did the State hire Gerrie Nel as its legal counsel;

- (iv) Bank of Botswana provided the State with an affidavit that clearly denied the theory that money was stolen under their watch and supervision, why the State did not disclose the existence of this affidavit to the public or even use it to avoid prosecuting an innocent person;
- (v) the High Court ordered that, Jako Hubona be charged with perjury for manufacturing evidence on behalf of the State, when is he, and others linked to him going to be charged if the matter is not filed yet, can the Minister update this Honourable House when the State is intending to do so and why at that particular time;
- (vi) with Hubona's skill-set of fabrication and manufacturing evidence, harm and injury was caused on the accused, has the State apologised or compensated the accused person for the fabrication he did, if not, why;
- (vii) what action has been taken against other individuals who participated at various capacities in helping Hubona in the name of the State in the fabrication of evidence; and
- (viii) in the current administration, is there anyone still in contact with Gerrie Nel.

2. KGOSI D. NDHOWE (OKAVANGO REGION): To ask the Minister of Local Government and Traditional Affairs to apprise this Honourable House on progress made regarding the upgrading of Headmen of Arbitration to Headmen of Record at the Tsodilo, Xhauga and Mokgacha villages which were gazetted in 2014. **(19)**

3. KGOSI C. O. PALEDI (KGALAGADI NORTH REGION): To ask the Minister of Lands and Agriculture whether he is aware that the cordon fence along the Hukuntsi/Kang road is in a bad condition; and if so, when he will repair it. **(20)**

- 4. KGOSI M. KHACHANA (NORTH EAST):** To ask the Minister of Lands and Agriculture to apprise this Honourable House on: **(21)**
- (i) the steps his ministry is taking to encourage youth participation in agriculture and make farming an attractive career option for young people; and
 - (ii) whether he will consider reserving a substantial amount of hectares of land purchased from the Tati Company Limited in the North East to lease to the youth for commercial farming projects.
- 5. KGOSI D. NDHOWE (OKAVANGO REGION):** To ask the Minister of Environment and Tourism to update this Honourable House on progress made regarding the construction of the Department of Wildlife and National Parks office at Seronga. **(22)**
- 6. KGOSI J. D. KHUMANEGO (NGWAKETSE WEST REGION):** To ask the Minister of Lands and Agriculture to state: **(23)**
- (i) the number of Thuo Letlotlo beneficiaries since its inception to date; and
 - (ii) the region with the highest number of beneficiaries as well as the region with the lowest number of beneficiaries.
- 7. KGOSI T. MUNDUU (NGAMI REGION):** To ask the Minister for State President to explain: **(24)**
- (i) whether he is aware that the office of Secretary of Ntlo ya Dikgosi (SNYD) is lower and not at the same level as that of the Clerk of the National Assembly (CNA); and if so, why the situation is like that;
 - (ii) why the life of Ntlo ya Dikgosi is tied to that of Parliament; and
 - (iii) when the Minister intends to address these concerns.

- 8. KGOSI L. M. BABEILE (K GALAGADI SOUTH REGION):** To ask the Minister of Lands and Agriculture if he will consider reducing ear tag prices to make it affordable for most farmers. **(25)**
- 9. KGOSI C. O. PALEDI (K GALAGADI NORTH REGION):** To ask the Minister of Environment and Tourism to state whether his ministry has any plans to use the salt pans that are found in Kgalagadi North for tourism activities; and if so, to state which ones in particular will be used to create jobs for the residents of that area. **(26)**
- 10. KGOSI M. KHACHANA (NORTH EAST):** To ask the Minister of Lands and Agriculture to explain how he will address the high mortality rate of the restocked cattle in Zone 6B following the Foot and Mouth Disease and the unavailability of veterinary officers in the district. **(27)**
- 11. KGOSI KHAMA IV (GA MMANGWATO):** To ask the Minister of Justice and Correctional Services if he is aware that in recent years, there have been numerous complaints including those from the Law Society of Botswana about captured Judges; and if so, what steps is the ministry taking to restore confidence and reputation in the Judiciary. **(28)**
- 12. KGOSI M. KHACHANA (NORTH EAST):** To ask the Minister for State President to apprise this Honourable House on measures the Government is taking to ensure that there is transparency and accountability in all ministries and departments in fighting corruption. **(29)**
- 13. KGOSI C. O. PALEDI (K GALAGADI NORTH REGION):** To ask the Minister of Lands and Agriculture to apprise this Honourable House on:- **(30)**
- (i) whether conservation committees that were under the Agricultural Resource Board which did outreach on the preservation of natural resources and prevention and/or control of veld fires are still operational;
 - (ii) if they are fulfilling the mandate they were established for; and
 - (iii) when they last convened.

- 14. KGOSI L. M. BABEILE (K GALAGADI SOUTH REGION):** To ask the Minister of Local Government and Traditional Affairs to apprise this Honourable House on:- **(31)**
- (i) the distinct career path for both Clerks and Bailiffs and their duties thereof to avoid overlapping and denying each discipline to progress along its cadre; and
 - (ii) the intervention measures he will put in place to rectify this anomaly.
- 15. KGOSI G. MONNATHEBE (KANYE REGION):** To ask the Minister of Lands and Agriculture if he is aware that the Keeper Identity Card for livestock owners expires after two (2) years and that the brand certificate expires after ten (10) years; and if so, whether he will consider aligning the two to expire at the same time. **(32)**
- 16. KGOSI M. KHACHANA (NORTH EAST):** To ask the Minister of Local Government and Traditional Affairs to explain why the eight (8) Dikgosi in the North East do not have Bathusa Kgosi. **(33)**
- 17. KGOSI G. MONNATHEBE (KANYE REGION):** To ask the Minister of Lands and Agriculture if he is aware that some matimela cattle are sold with visible brands, earmarks and the Botswana Animal Identification and Traceability System (BAITS) ear tags; and if so, whether it is not ideal to contact the owners as their details are in the system. **(34)**

(FOR ORAL ANSWER ON WEDNESDAY 25TH JUNE, 2025)

- 1. KGOSI T. MUNDUU (NGAMI REGION):** To ask the Minister of Local Government and Traditional Affairs to inform this Honourable House whether he has any plans to:- **(35)**
- (i) recognise Headmen of Arbitration and include them in the Bogosi Act; and

(ii) employ the above on a permanent and pensionable basis to allow them to access the associated benefits as well as to address their current conditions of service which impede their well-being and good health.

2. **KGOSI C. O. PALEDI (KGALAGADI NORTH REGION):** To ask the Minister of Transport and Infrastructure if he has any plans to convert the Lehututu-Hunhukwe road to bitumen as it is in a bad state of disrepair. **(36)**
3. **KGOSI T. M. MONYEPPELE (TSWAPONG REGION):** To ask the Minister of Local Government and Traditional Affairs to state when the Maunatlala Kgotla will be fully resourced to bring it to the same level as the Palapye Kgotla. **(37)**
4. **KGOSI D. NDHOWE (OKAVANGO REGION):** To ask the Minister of Justice and Correctional Services to state when he will develop the Botswana Prisons Service plot at Sepopa village as per his response to Ntlo ya Dikgosi Question 693 asked on Friday 1st February, 2019. **(38)**
5. **KGOSI M. I P. TUMAELETSE IV (SPECIALLY ELECTED):** To ask the Minister of Local Government and Traditional Affairs to state if he is aware of the remuneration disparity in the Bogosi structure; and if so, what measures he will put in place to restructure and create new posts as follows:- **(39)**
 - (i) remunerate all the twelve (12) Dikgosi who are recognised by Section 77 (1) (a) (i)-(xii) of the Constitution of Botswana to E band salary scale;
 - (ii) remunerate Mothusa Kgosi and Headman of Records at D1 salary scale equivalent to Urban Customary Court President;
 - (iii) remunerate Moemela Mothusa Kgosi yo Mogolwane at D2 salary scale;
 - (iv) remunerate Moemela Mothusa Kgosi at D3 salary scale;

(v) employ and remunerate Mogolwane wa Motse (Senior Member of the Tribe) at D4 scale in terms of Section 2 and 6(1) of the Bogosi Act No. 9 of 2008 based on meritocracy, competence, academic qualification and experience of an individual member; and

(vi) employ on permanent and pensionable terms and remunerate Headmen of Arbitration at C4-C1 multiple grading scale based on meritocracy, competence, academic qualifications and experience of an individual.

6. **KGOSI N. KABELO (SEROWE REGION):** To ask the Minister of Child Welfare and Basic Education if she is aware that retired teachers receive their packages or benefits after seven (7) months to a year; and if so, what measures she will put in place to curb this delay. **(40)**
7. **KGOSI T. M. MONYEPELE (TSWAPONG REGION):** To ask the Minister of Transport and Infrastructure whether he is aware of the many road accidents that occur at the railway crossing on the A1 road junction from Palapye that turns towards Kgagodi-Bobonong; and if so, when he will address this matter to curb the frequent accidents. **(41)**
8. **KGOSI M. KHACHANA (NORTH EAST):** To ask the Minister for State President to explain why Government purchases high end vehicles for top officials; and further state, how much in terms of budget has been used in the past five (5) financial years for such. **(42)**
9. **KGOSI D. NDHOWE (OKAVANGO REGION):** To ask the Minister of Local Government and Traditional Affairs if he is aware that the Okavango East Customary Courts for the villages of Gudigwa, Seronga, Eretsha and Sekondomboro have had vacant posts of Clerk Assistant for a long period of time; and if so, when the posts will be filled. **(43)**

- 10. KGOSI KHAMA IV (GA MMANGWATO):** To ask the Minister of Transport and Infrastructure if he is aware that the airstrips that used to be in Serowe, Mahalapye, Bobonong and Rakops are no longer operational; and if so, in order to facilitate air transport and the contribution it makes to a country's economy, will the Minister consider operationalising those and other airstrips around the country to boost the aviation sector. **(44)**
- 11. KGOSI M. KHACHANA (NORTH EAST):** To ask the Minister of Justice and Correctional Services if he does not deem it necessary to translate all statutes/Acts to Setswana. **(46)**
- 12. KGOSI T. M. MONYEPELE (TSWAPONG REGION):** To ask the Minister of Local Government and Traditional Affairs to state when he will:- **(47)**
- (i) build comprehensive facilities in small villages to enhance the system of customary courts that exist; and
 - (ii) broaden laws that are applied by customary courts and commission smaller offices in Dikgotla to deal with issues of inheritance as they get delayed at the master's court.
- 13. KGOSI KHAMA IV (GA MMANGWATO):** To ask the Minister of Transport and Infrastructure whether he is aware that many roads such as Francistown–Nata, Serowe–Letlhakane–Makalamabedi, Nata–Maun, are in urgent need of repairs, amongst others; and if so, what timeline the ministry is working on to effect repair on these roads and others. **(48)**
- 14. KGOSI M. KHACHANA (NORTH EAST):** To ask the Minister of Finance to inform this Honourable House on what the Government is doing to diversify the economy beyond the reliance on one commodity which is diamonds. **(49)**

15. KGOSI G. MONNATHEBE (KANYE REGION): To ask the Minister (50) for State President to inform this Honourable House of:-

(i) the total number of specially elected Headmen of Arbitration to Ntlo ya Dikgosi since the introduction of Specially Elected Members; and

(ii) the criteria used in their selection.

16. KGOSI M. KHACHANA (NORTH EAST): To ask the Minister of (51) Local Government and Traditional Affairs to state when he will install modern computers and connect Wi-Fi in all Dikgotla that have not yet been connected.

1. KGOSI D. NDHOWE (OKAVANGO REGION): To ask the Minister (52) of Local Government and Traditional Affairs to state when he will employ permanent office cleaners at Etsha 1 Customary Court office, as the office has never had cleaners since its construction in 2016.

2. KGOSI T. MUNDUU (NGAMI REGION): To ask the Minister of (53) Lands and Agriculture to state when he will advertise the Kareng Phase III farms.

3. KGOSI M. I P. TUMAELETSE IV (SPECIALLY ELECTED): To ask (54) the Minister of Transport and Infrastructure to apprise this Honourable House on his intention to maintain and upgrade the Tsabong-Kokotsha and Tsabong-McCathy's Rust roads.

4. KGOSI J. D. KHUMANEGO (NGWAKETSE WEST REGION): To (55) ask the Minister of Local Government and Traditional Affairs to state if he has any plans to provide communication allowance to Headmen of Arbitration, Headmen of Record and Baemela Kgosi.

- 5. KGOSI C. O. PALEDI (K GALAGADI NORTH REGION):** To ask the Minister of Child Welfare and Basic Education to explain to this Honourable House why Hunhukwe Primary School boarding students who come from neighboring villages, some as far as Kang, are transported using trucks instead of truck buses considering the fact that some of them are under the age of six (6). **(56)**
- 6. KGOSI L. M. BABEILE (K GALAGADI SOUTH REGION):** To ask the Minister of Transport and Infrastructure to state when he will replace the following boarded vehicles:- **(57)**
- (i) Khuis – BX 09 5821;
 - (ii) Kisa – BX 14 1199;
 - (iii) Kokotsha – BX 09 5821;
 - (iv) Tsabong – BX 09 5903;
 - (v) Kolonkwaneng – BX 08 3961 (2024); and
 - (vi) Omaweneno – BX 05 1243.
- 7. KGOSI KHAMA IV (GA MMANGWATO):** To ask the Minister of Lands and Agriculture whether he is aware that the Ngwato Landboard Secretary position has been vacant for five (5) years; and if so, when it will be filled. **(58)**
- 8. KGOSI G. MONNATHEBE (KANYE REGION):** To ask the Minister of Local Government and Traditional Affairs if he is aware that some customary courts in Kanye Region which are headed by Chief Representatives do not have Headmen of Record, as a result, offices remain vacant when the incumbent officers are on leave; and if so, when he will address the situation. **(59)**
- 9. KGOSI T. M. MONYEPELE (TSWAPONG REGION):** To ask the Minister of Transport and Infrastructure to state when he will convert the Lesenepole-Maunatlala-Mokokwana-Mosweu-Seolwane road to bitumen. **(60)**

- 10. KGOSI M. I P. TUMAELETSE IV (SPECIALLY ELECTED):** To ask the Minister of Transport and Infrastructure to apprise this Honourable House on his intention to convert the following roads to bitumen:- **(61)**
- (i) Werda/Hereford/Mabule;
 - (ii) Hereford/Khakhea/Mabutsane;
 - (iii) Khuis/Khawa;
 - (iv) Bokspits/Kgalagadi Transfontier Park;
 - (v) Tsabong/Mabuasehube Park/Hukuntsi;
 - (vi) the seven (7) kilometre Maleshe road leading to Tsabong-Sekoma Junction; and further state, the dates for commencement and completion of this process.
- 11. KGOSI T. M. MONYEPELE (TSWAPONG REGION):** To ask the Minister of Child Welfare and Basic Education to state when she will renovate Moeng College, which is in a bad state of disrepair thereby posing a health hazard to both students and teachers. **(62)**
- 12. KGOSI KHAMA IV (GA MMANGWATO):** To ask the Minister for State President to explain that since the two (2) main perpetrators of abuse of office in Government brought about the situation that necessitated a forensic audit, and as one exited Government on the 30th October, 2024 but the other continued in his position in Government to abuse his office into 2025:- **(63)**
- (i) why is the audit not including this period as well; and
 - (ii) as the audit includes the last three (3) years of the administration prior to 2018, why should it not include the whole period of that administration that began in 2008, especially to investigate the Butterfly saga that was said to have occurred in that year under that administration and reveal whether such a huge amount of public funds was stolen; and if not, to expose who was behind the fabrication.

- 13. KGOSI J. D. KHUMANEGO (NGWAKETSE WEST REGION):** To ask the Minister of Local Government and Traditional Affairs if he is aware that two (2) positions for Headman of Arbitration at Ikageng ward in Morwamosu and Moshana ward in Keng were taken by the then Minister; and if so, when he intends to return the above posts. **(64)**
- 14. KGOSI T. M. MONYEPELE (TSWAPONG REGION):** To ask the Minister of Child Welfare and Basic Education if she will consider converting Bakgopheng Junior Secondary School to a unified secondary school as it is at the centre of many villages and has enough land for further development. **(65)**
- 15. KGOSI T. MUNDUU (NGAMI REGION):** To ask the Minister of Local Government and Traditional Affairs whether he will consider creating a post of a cleaner at Bothatogo Customary Court in the North West District. **(66)**

- 1. KGOSI M. KHACHANA (NORTH EAST):** To ask the Minister of Lands and Agriculture to state the plans he has in place to address challenges of access to agricultural inputs such as good quality seeds, fertilizers and machinery. **(67)**
- 2. KGOSI L. M. BABEILE (KGALAGADI SOUTH REGION):** To ask the Minister of Local Government and Traditional Affairs if he will consider upgrading some Dikgotla in Kgalagadi South Region as they do not match the current status of developments and changes. **(68)**
- 3. KGOSI C. O. PALEDI (KGALAGADI NORTH REGION):** To ask the Minister of Health to explain to this Honourable House:- **(69)**
- (i) why the arrangement of visiting specialist doctors such as the orthopedic surgeon who used to visit the Hukuntsi Primary Hospital was stopped; and
 - (ii) if he is aware that there is an acute shortage of water at Hukuntsi Primary Hospital; and if so, whether he will consider connecting large water tanks to ease the severe impact felt due to lack of water.

4. **KGOSI M. KHACHANA (NORTH EAST):** To ask the Minister of Local Government and Traditional Affairs to explain to this Honourable House why Vukwi Customary Court in the North East has not been upgraded to the level of Headman of Record. (70)
5. **KGOSI N. KABELO (SEROWE REGION):** To ask the Minister of Health whether he will consider hiring sign language interpreters in all districts and referral hospitals in Botswana to cater for the deaf. (71)
6. **KGOSI C. O. PALEDI (K GALAGADI NORTH REGION):** To ask the Minister of Local Government and Traditional Affairs if he has any plans to construct Tribal Administration offices at Monong settlement and upgrade the Lehututu Tribal Administration office; and if so, when. (72)
7. **KGOSI M. KHACHANA (NORTH EAST):** To ask the Minister of Lands and Agriculture if he will consider introducing a Crop Intensification Programme (CIP) initiative to enhance agricultural productivity and ensure food security and low food prices. (73)
8. **KGOSI L. M. BABEILE (K GALAGADI SOUTH REGION):** To ask the Minister of Local Government and Traditional Affairs to state when he will construct institutional houses for Tribal Administration staff at Tsabong District as it is the case with other Ministries. (74)
